### Nutrition Health Review: The Consumer's Medical Journal

*Full Text:* 03/01/1990 to present  
Description: A medical journal for consumers, medical news from around the world, articles of note from professional journals, questions and answers and book reviews.

### FDA Consumer

*Full Text:* 06/01/1990 to present  
Description: Presents articles dealing with consumer interests and education. Published by the Food and Drug Administration.

### Consumer Reports Buying Guide

*Full Text:* 01/01/1999 to present  
Description: A product-test and consumer advisory publication. Publishes results of tests on products ranging from major purchases such as automobiles & appliances to everyday items such as food & cleaning products.

### Consumer Reports on Health

*Full Text:* 01/01/1992 to present  
Description: Information for consumers on health and health issues aimed at enhancing the quality of life. Not intended as a substitute for professional or medical advice.

### TWICE: This Week in Consumer Electronics

*Full Text:* 07/12/1999 to present  
Description: The business-trade newspaper for consumer electronics, computers, software, video, telephones, blank media & major appliances.

### HealthFacts

*Full Text:* 01/01/1994 to present  
Description: Aimed at the medical consumer. Articles on drugs available to mitigate specific conditions, information on drug advertising and alternative health choices.
